



Parent-Student Awareness: A Family Affair 2-Day AD/HD Conference

This two-day conference begins with a strong self-awareness of how AD/HD affects behavioral and academic success at home and in school. Rich dialogues and reflective practices will provide needed opportunities to integrate planners effectively.

Setting up a Mini-AD/HD Conference:

Audience: Educators, Administrators, Parents & Children (9 yrs & older)

Fees: \$140 per family (2 adults and up to 3 children)

\$115 per educator or counselor
